How to create a PDF file

If you can print the file ... you can convert it to a PDF for free!

You don't actually need a printer to create a free PDF document from your original document, but it's as easy as printing. The first thing you need to do is download a program called [CutePDF writer](#), look for the "free download" link. After downloading CutePDF Writer, install the software by double clicking on the downloaded file and choosing the default installation options.

That's really all there is to it. Now every time you have a file you need to convert into a PDF file simply go to the file menu and choose print, just like you would if you were to print the file normally. Once the print dialog box appears choose CutePDF Writer as your printer in name drop down box and print. The CutePDF Writer then asks you for the file name and location you would like to save the file. Enter this information and click save, CutePDF Writer then creates the PDF file and you're all done, you've just converted your document into a PDF file for free!

The only downside to this free PDF creation tool is you can't modify the PDF file after it's created, you have to modify the original and then recreate it. But don't worry, if you're willing to pay a little CutePDF has a tool called CutePDF Professional that allows you to edit PDF files.

So what is a PDF file?

The acronym PDF stands for Portable Document File. The PDF file format was created by the Adobe Corporation to make the process of transferring files between different computers and languages easier, all you need a free PDF reader program ([Adobe Reader](#) - formally called Adobe Acrobat Reader) on the computer.

Before the PDF file was created you had to have the original source program used to create the file installed on every computer. This isn't always possible since some programs cost hundreds, even thousands of dollars. Purchasing a license to product this expensive just so someone can view a file doesn't make a whole lot of sense. With the invent of the PDF document all you have to do is convert the file to the PDF format and install a free PDF reader on the other computers.
